Windows

We divide them into a "Design Series," to keep the daylight openings and lines consistent. Now with 1 3/4" thick sash standard

~

Hung Series: e.g. Double Hung, Single Hung, Triple Hung, Double Hung Fixed, Double Hung Transom, Single (Do) Fixed.

~

Horizontal Series: e.g. Casement, Awning or Fixed Sash configured Horizontally

~

Vertical Series: e.g. Casement, Awning or Fixed Sash configured Vertically

~

Slider Series: e.g. Horizontally Sliding Window

~

Picture Window Series: e.g. Direct set glass in a single master frame

~

Combination Windows: Refer to any window/window or window/door combination, ganged or mullied together to fill one opening in the structure.

~

Specialty Windows: Octagon, Gable, Arch, Round, Corner or any do-able alteration of design. We like to call this, coloring outside the lines.



Doors

-Available in 1 3/4" and 2 1/4" leaf thickness

-Stile & Rail construction accommodates glass and panels.

-Layered doors can take on many configurations, barn door style, "plank" build up, skinned overhead.

-Thick or thin stiles, Engineered or solid lumber

-Door Hanging: the jamb portion "of a pre-hung door" or function.

-Exterior Doors: Hinge Hung, Entry Door Packages, Bi-Fold, Lift & Slide, Big Door Leafs, Track Systems, Pivot.

-Interior Doors: Hinge Hung, Pocket, Bi-fold
